Frederick James Tiltman, brother of my great grandmother Jane Carter Tiltman was born at the Coast Guard cottages in Kelly's Ave Kingstown, Rathdown, Dublin 25-5-1871. Also born there, Jane Carter Tiltman 1st March 1873 also Henry Tiltman 14th Jan 1875 and Catherine Ann Tiltman 15 March 1876. All born in Cahiroe, Kilkatherine, Castle Town, Cork. Timothy Bible born 16-8-1824 in Ashada married Charlotte Elizabeth Tiltman sister of James Carter Tiltman (Aunt to our great grandmother. He had returned from the Crimea war where he was 2nd Captain of the Main Top on H.M.S. Jean D'Arc, his father Thomas William Tiltman used influence to get him transferred to the Coast Guard Service. In 1900 Great grandfather was a carpenter stationed on HMS Melampus the Kingstown reserve drill ship in Rathdown, Dublin. In 1901 he was living with wife Jane Carter, daughters Dorothy and Annie, son William at 32 Main St, Cove Village at the Coast Guard Station. In 1902 Kathleen was born followed by my grandfather John Francis in 1904 at Summer Cove, Kinsale. In 1911 the family were living in Coast Guard accommodation at Castlehaven, Cork. Great Grandfather died at sea and the in-lire family emigrated to the Isle of Wight, England in March 1915
