Thomas Browne was born in Fahouragh Castlehaven Cork on 02nd Sept 1866. His parents were William Browne & Mary Heas. Thomas Browne was married on 3rd Feb 1887 at Castlehaven, Cork and they had 11 children, William Stephen 1888-1899, Mary Ellen 1890-1953, John 1892-, Patrick 1894-1940, Thomas 1895, Annie 1897-1907, Jane 1899-, Margaret Teresa 1901-1990, Timothy Charles 1903-1984, James Edward 1904, Michael Joseph 1908-1989. Patrick Browne joined the Royal Navy 6th Jan 1912 and transferred to reserves on 1st Jan 1929. He was called up in 1939 and failed his medical. He married Margaret Elizabeth Hendry on 28th Sept 1918 in Oban Cathedral and had four children, Patricia Mary Helen 2nd Jul 1919 - 2004, Ronald Kennedy 6th Jan 1929-2012, Jennie 27th May 1935-2003 and Winifride 17 Jun 1936- 2018. Patricia Mary Helen married William McGowan Dyer (1921-1970) on 4th Oct 1952 and they had 6 children. Ronald Browne married Jean Humm in 1959 and had three children. Jennie was a spinster. Winifride married Angus MacDonald in 1962 and had 4 children. Michael Joseph Browne 1908-1989 married Teresa Coughlan 1920-2018 22 Aug 1942 in Aughadown, Cork and had 12 children. Michael moved to Youghal in 1943 and purchased land to run a dairy farm, which the family still have today. Most of the other Browne's emigrated to America.

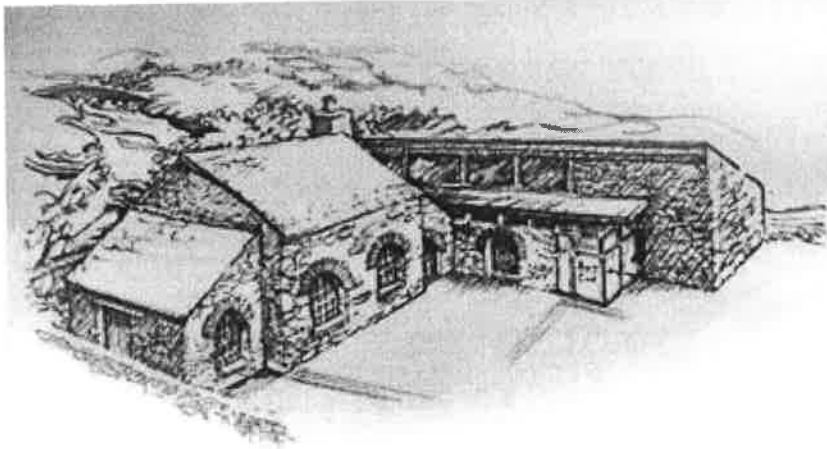

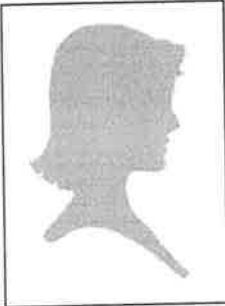

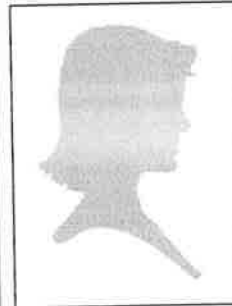
