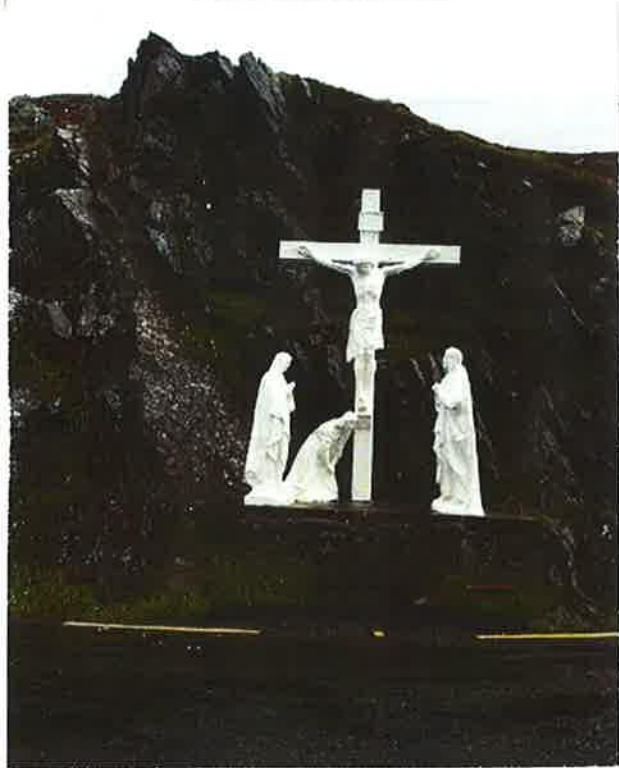


Tadgh O'Flaherty
