Proclamation out side the GPO on the 24th of April 1916
He was executed along with 14 others. He was only 36 years
old. He Rests at arbot hill Prison near Hurston Station in
Co Dublin along with James Connolly. He was known as
the highest member of the I.R.B. that was the Irish Republican
Brotherhood. On the 1st of August 1915 He gave a grave
side speech at Jeremiah O' Doherty's funeral. The Irish was
from Roscathery. His words were IRELAND UNFREE will never
be at Peace.
