

Nellius Kelly was born in Gloun in 1895
At the time of the ambush he was 25 or 26
years old. Kilmichael ambush was seemingly planned
in his house in Gloun which standing today
and in good condition. History has it that it
was planned in a room upstairs in the ~~main~~ house.
The window was taken out so ~~that~~ that if any
British soldiers came they could escape quickly.
From Kilmichael ambush they fled on towards
Johnstown and then made a detour past Nellius house
on to Aghateera and all
the way back to Balinnacarriga

Nellius went to prison in England after
