My great great grandmother Margeret Falvey Owned a house in Innishvalla (townland outside Inishannon). Her house was one of the only houses that wasn't a farm house. During the war of independence 17 soldiers came to her house and stayed there

During 1921 you had to have a list of names on the doors so the postmen could deliver letters but one day there were rumors about british soldiers coming to look for Irish soldiers.

Margeret was not supporting british rule and had a smart idea. She took the list down and set to work writing a new list. In the afternoon the British general came to look at the list. He thought it was a normal house and carried on looking. So when ever the british generals were coming she would put up the other list.

Margeret was born in 1864.

My great granduncle is called Jerry Murphy. (Born in 1885. Jerry lived on the main street in Innishannon west cork. Jerry went to Innishannon national school.

Jerry had no sisters but had five brothers. He was the oldest in his family. My grandad Paddy Murphy was a plasterer. Jerry taught Paddy to be a plasterer.

On the 20th of February 1918 Jerry planted a bomb in the RIC (Royal Irish Constabulary) Barrack. It was set to go off later in the day. Jerry was thirty three when he planted the bomb. Fortunately for the guards the bomb did not go off. The guards found the bomb three days later.
