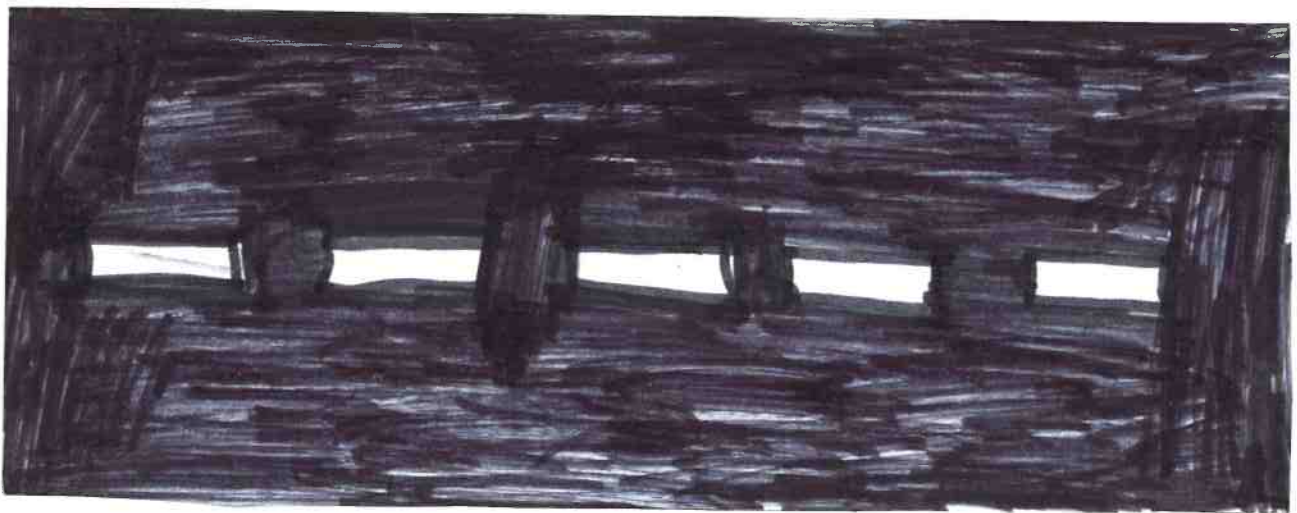


My great great

surname is O'Brien. Joes
death was almost
overshadowed by Terence
MacSwiney who was the
lord major. Timothy
wanted a pension for
Joes death.

Joe had keen interest
in the Gaelic sports
and did hurling for
the old Plunketts club
in Yoghke and also
enjoyed a game of
road bowling on most
Sunday mornings. Joe
went to Yoghke N.S. In
1940 there was a road
named after Joe Murphy.
