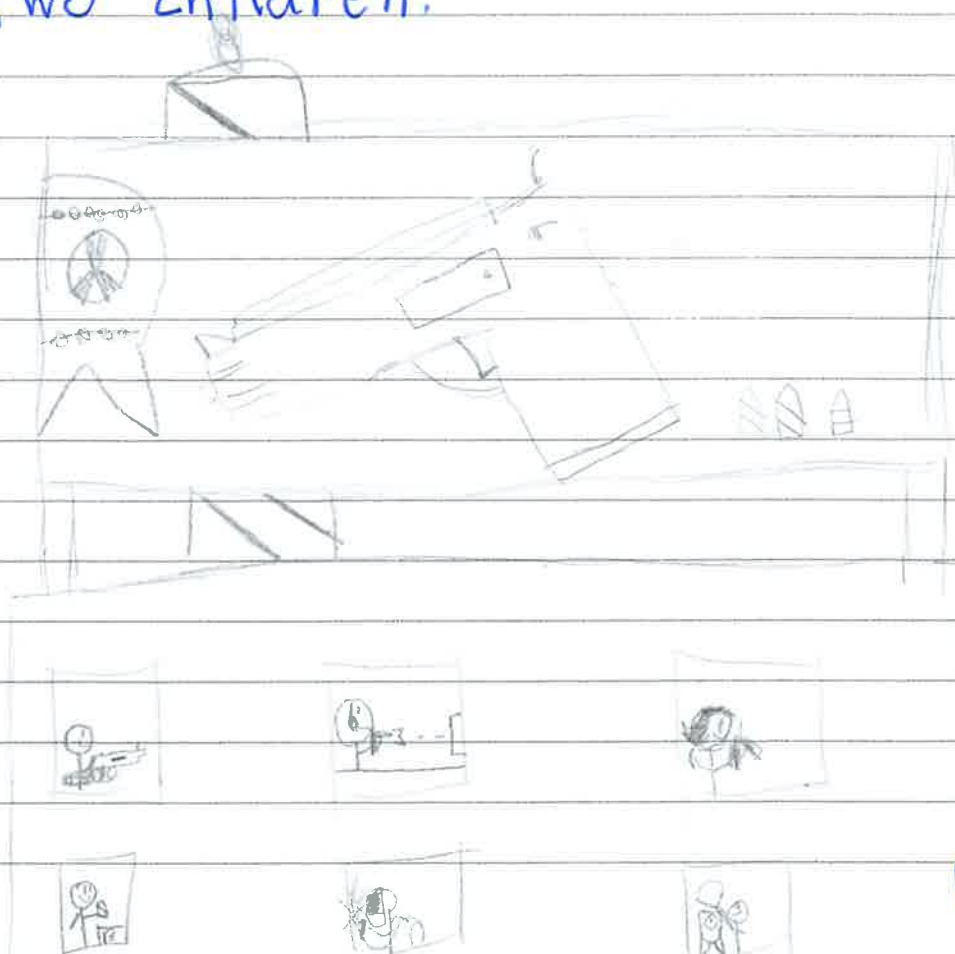


Firing pins
