

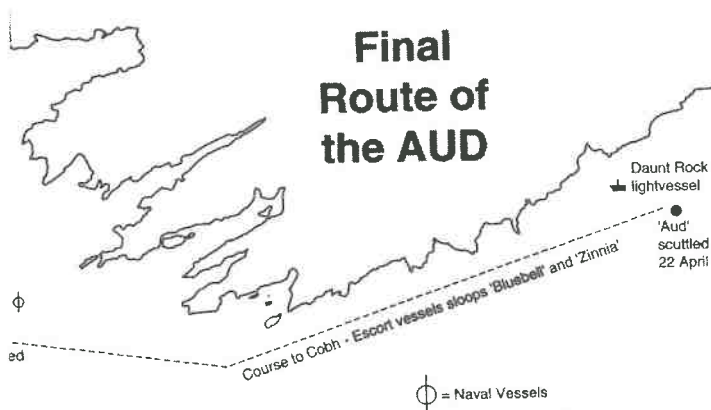

# 1916

My Great Grand-Uncle Micheál was one of the men who was going to take the weapons off the Aud in Fenit on April 19<sup>th</sup>. The date of the Rising was changed to April 23<sup>rd</sup>. There was no radio on the ship, so they didn't know the change of plans.



The ship arrived in Fenit on April 21<sup>st</sup> but my Great Grand-Uncle was not expecting it. No help was given to the crew to unload the weapons.



The British discovered the ship which fled but was captured and later scuttled. Although my family was ready to play its part in the Rebellion, it never got a chance!
