Reasons.

In a Field near Windmill rock in High street Skibbereen,
The Local council would get onto the guards in the
Garda Station who would accompany My great grandfather
To the TNT Shelter as the guards would have the key to all
The explosives, MY great grandfather could only do his job
At night, His work Entailed blowing away rock to make
And widen roads clearing sites and Demolition,
He blew up a lot of places around Skibbereen and the
West Cork area. He started in the 1920`s and was doing
His job for of over 40 Years.
