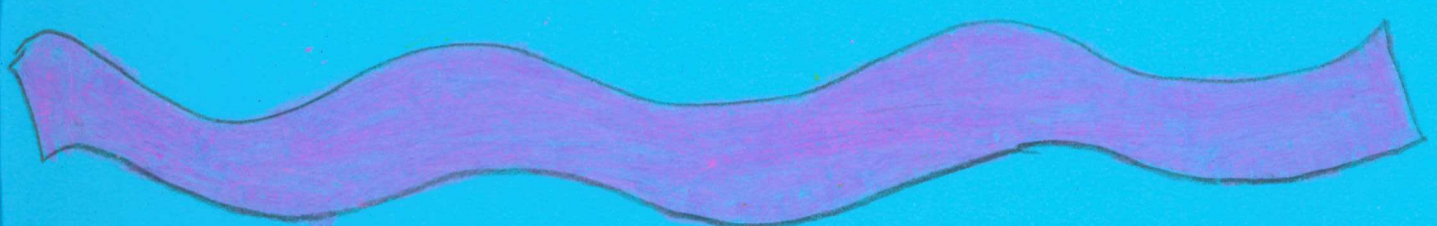


MY
