Michael McLean lived in Lowertown, Schull (near Gaggan). British forces captured Michael in the house of Charlie Hurley and he reported him. They tortured him mercilessly (showing no mercy). Michael had not died in combat. Michael had injured his hand sometime after the Kilmicheal Ambush. He was sent off to go and find the residence of loyalists of John and Annie Duke but didn't find them and on the way he was captured. This incident took place on the 8th of December, 1920. After they had tortured him for some years they murdered and shot him at the age of 23.
