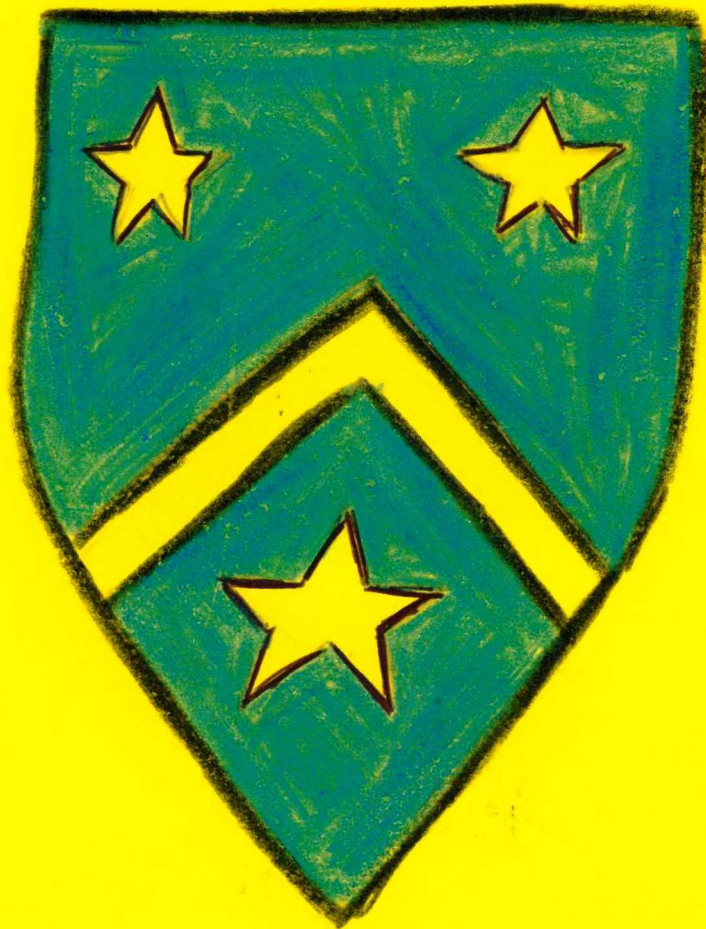


My Great

My source of information is my grandad from my dad's side. His name is John Antony Mannix. My story is about my great grand father, Cornelius Mannix.

Cornelius was born in 1898 into a Roman Catholic family. His parents were John and Kate Mannix. Kate's maiden name was Creedon. He had five other siblings and he was the second youngest. Cornelius grew up in Mallow.

He joined the I.R.A during the War of Independence and fought against the free staters in the Civil War. He also fought the Black and Tans in the War of Independence.

Cornelius Mannix died at the age of sixty-seven years old in 1965. He is buried in St. Patrick's church yard, Dunmanway.
