In 1920 My Grandad's cousin saw Michael
Ollins on the run dressed as a priest in Augh
rim, Co. Galway. My Great Granny and her five
nd were sleeping and were woken up in the
middle of the night by the Black and Tans to
check if there was anyone else in the house in
the early 1920's in Inagh, Co. Galway. My Great
Grandad heard that in a Catholic church in
Kinsale, Co. Cork, the priest would not
forgive murder in confession in 1921-22.

My Great Uncle went to school, on the
way he had to cross the bridge
and the British Police had to check if
they had any dangerous weapons in
Kinsale Co. Cork in the early 1920's.
