

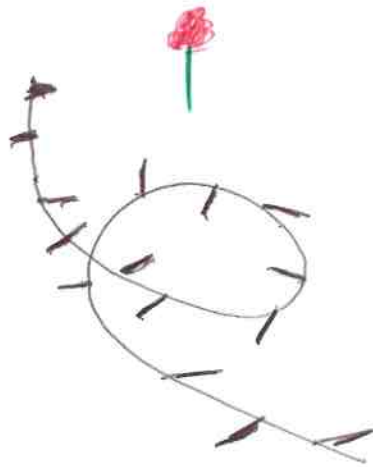

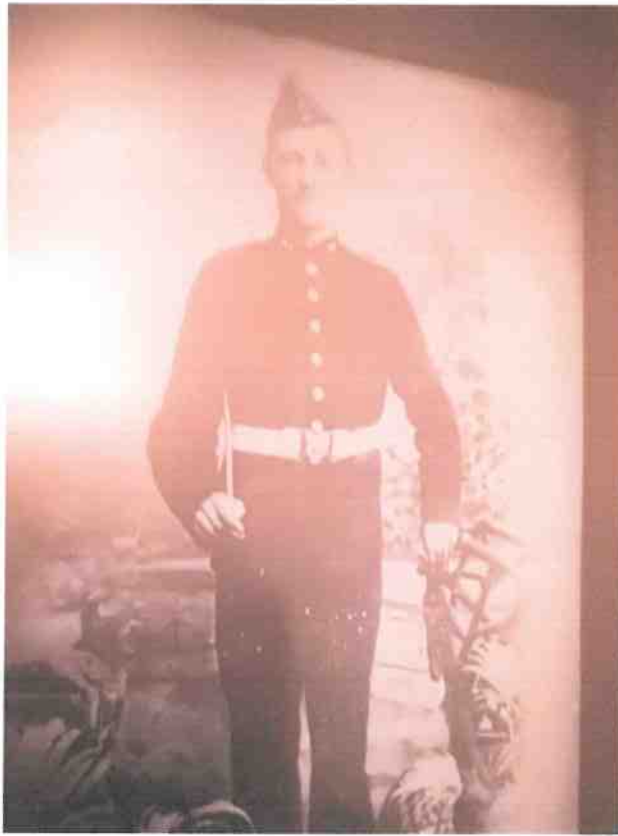

World War I (often abbreviated as **WWI** or **WW1**), also known as the **First World War**, the **Great War**, the **Seminal Catastrophe**, and initially in North America as the **European War**, was a [global war](#) originating in [Europe](#) that lasted from 28 July 1914 to 11 November 1918. Contemporaneously described as "[the war to end all wars](#)",^[7] it led to the mobilisation of more than 70 million [military personnel](#), including 60 million Europeans, making it one of the largest wars in history.^{[8][9]} It is also [one of the deadliest conflicts in history](#),^[10] with an estimated nine million [combatants](#) and seven million [civilian deaths as a direct result of the war](#), while [resulting genocides](#) and the resulting [1918 influenza pandemic](#) caused another 50 to 100 million deaths worldwide.^[11]

away, John was buried in France 1916.



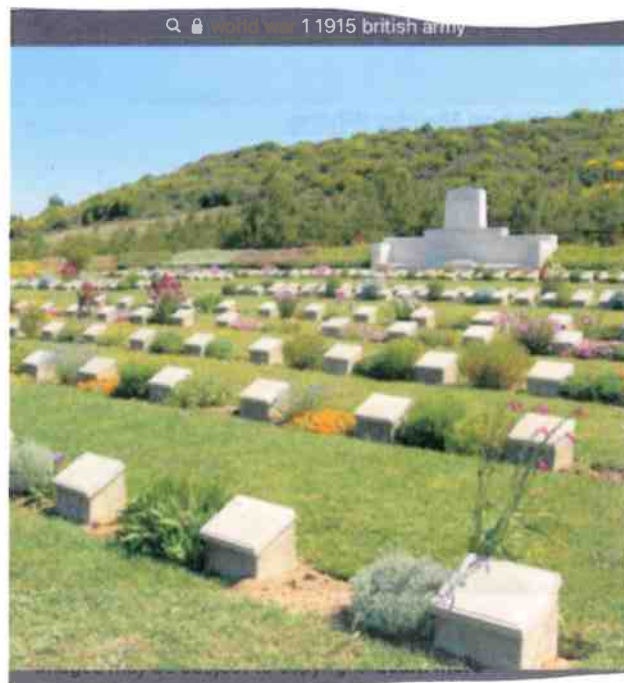
