June 10th 1894.

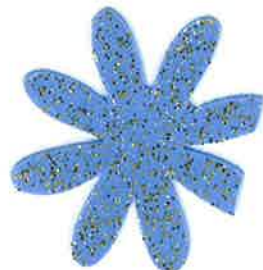
