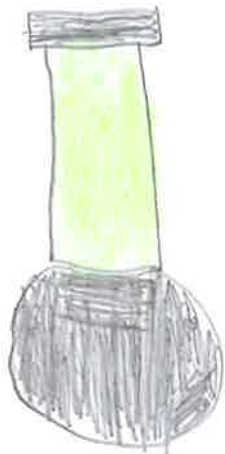
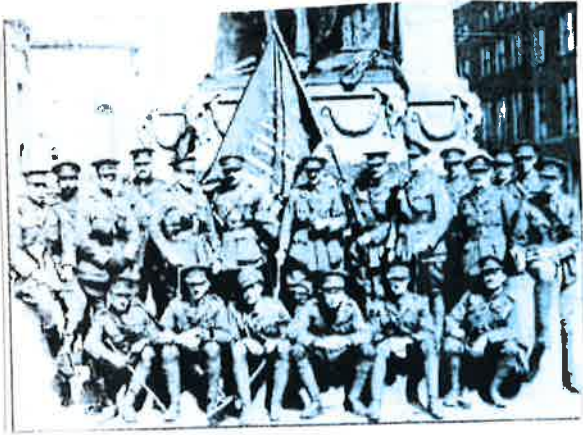
My great grandfather Cornilius o Sullivan was a part of the Irish volunteers for the 1916 rising , Early in 1918 the area was organised to go to Ballinasig for a meeting, Soon later at this time there were stations in Bandon, Ballinadee, Kilbrittain ,Innishannon ,Barryroe ,Timoleague, Tinkers cross ,Kilpatrick and Quawys cross. These stations were now organised as Bandon battled at Cork bridgegate.

The only type of training carried on in the early stage was close order drill in the fillgle in the area , Parades were held twice weekly and occasionally they went on route marchers ,On Sunday evening to company areas

While my great grandfather was in jail he needed to MAKE up some of his time so he got coins and started making rings out of the coins, Then he started to go on to make more metal pieces like badges made out of bullets, and one of the rings my great grandfather made he had carved the word spike on to one of the rings and he got the word spike from spike island the jail he was in, all the pieces he made are still kept.

They were busy trying to fight off the British soldiers and risking their lives to save our country ,My great grandfather got arrested by the British soldiers because he was fighting for freedom, And he was kept in jail for 9 months.
