My great grandmother Maryanne Bohane was a small girl with her brother. One night she always remembers and use to tell this to my grandmother Nora Keohane that when the men called from the IRA they took her father away. The children and their mother were terrified. They had big sticks and were beating them off the floor. Her father had to tackle up a horse and cart and drive these people to Bantry <sup>being</sup> threatened all the way. My great grand mother <sup>and</sup> her brother and mother thought they would never see him alive. Thank God to their delight the following day he returned safely. My gran aunt Theresa Hickey coronea told me this as her mother use often tell her about this story from Marie O Sullivan 4<sup>th</sup> class
