## Charleville Heroes

My name is Síofra Hegarty and my Great Grandfather Joe Nagle and his two brothers Garret and Richard Nagle were members of the Irish Volunteers. They were arrested in 1916 and spent six weeks in Limerick jail. They then served in the I.R.A (Irish Republican Army) during the War of Independence and the Civil War. Joe Nagle had a harness and saddle shop near the A.I.C (Royal Irish Constabulary) barracks, so he watched them and reported back. He later met his wife Margaret O'Sullivan in Bantry Co. Cork when she was visiting her brother Micheal. For more information, Joe is mentioned in the Military Archives.
